Curriculum

- We offer residents comprehensive office procedure training and preparation to obtain full hospital privileges, including critical care and obstetrics
- Each site provides training for residents to incorporate OMT into their clinical practice
- All of our residency programs are dually accredited by the ACGME and AOA/ACOFM, and program graduates are eligible to take both the AOBFP and ABFM certification exams
- Our residents experience rural, urban, suburban and underserved practice settings
- Residents gain experience in local communities, and also benefit from the opportunities available through connection with a large, statewide public university system
- Osteopathic residents and faculty come together 4x per year for hands-on OMT workshops
